

POOL RULES

ID is required to enter the facility when lifeguards are on duty.

1. No one is allowed in the pool unless a Lifeguard is on duty or on deck.
2. Obey all instructions of the Lifeguard(s). The lifeguard has absolute authority to enforce all club rules.
3. A parent or responsible adult must be within arm's reach of any child using flotation devices in the pool.
4. No running on deck (concrete area of the pool).
5. No rough play in or around the pool.
6. No disorderly conduct is allowed on Club property.
7. Do not swim near the diving board when it is in use. One at a time on the board. Keep the pool clear beneath the board. Be sure the pool is clear before diving.
8. No back dives from the side of the pool.
9. All infants & non-toilet trained toddlers must wear swim diapers.
10. No food, drinks, or glass in or near the pool.
11. Lifeguards may, at their discretion, decide that no foreign objects are allowed in or around the pool. (Flotation Devices, Balls, Frisbees, etc.)
12. No flotation devices in the deep end of the pool.
13. No swimming under pool cover.
14. Members are responsible for replacement of any damaged property.
15. Members are not permitted inside the parking lot gate before 8am or after 10:00pm during the months of June - September. All other months, the facilities must be vacated by 9:00pm.
16. Per our Conditional Use Permit, the pool closes at 9:00 pm and the club facility closes at 10:00pm during the months of June - September. Members must depart once the facility is closed. All other months, members are only permitted on premise from 8:00 am to 9:00 pm. Please see Pool Hours for more information.
17. No electronically amplified sounds permitted at the club, including but not limited to radios, karaoke machines, loudspeakers or cell phones with the speaker turned on.
18. Hard balls and water balloons are not permitted in the pool.
19. Sidewalk chalk and paint are not allowed inside the Club.

20. The wading pool is specifically for children age 5 and under, who must be accompanied by an adult. Lifeguards are not responsible for monitoring the children in the wading pool.
21. Adult swim takes place on a rotation schedule for 20 minutes increments. Please refer to the pool hours for adult swim times. During this time, only those in their Junior year of High School or older are permitted in the pool, and no lifeguard will be on duty. A Student/School ID MUST be provided for anyone that appears to be under the age of 18 wanting to partake in Adult Swim.
22. Guest passes are \$5 per person for all non-members entering the Club, regardless of whether or not they utilize the pool, tennis courts, or basketball court.
23. Children in 7th grade or younger may not be left unattended at the club. You must be at least a Junior in High School or older to supervise someone at the club that is not yet in 8th Grade. You must be able to provide a student ID upon entering the club. The lifeguards will hold the Student ID for the duration of the time that the unattended minor is at the club.
24. Bicycle, scooter, and skateboard riding is not permitted at the club. This includes the Tennis and Basketball Court.
25. Tables may not be "held". Tables are available on a "first come" basis. A member must be physically present at the Club to reserve an area. Anyone laying out a table setting and leaving the Club, will have their items removed and placed by the Guard Shack.
26. Chairs and lounge chairs are for sitting and laying ONLY! Please put chairs and lounge chairs away after use.
27. Children who repeatedly fail to follow Club rules may be ejected from the pool for the day and may also be restricted to use the Club only while his or her parent is in attendance.
28. Animals are not allowed in the Club.
29. All members & their guests are responsible for observance of all pool rules.

GUEST WRISTBANDS

1. The purchase price for guest wristbands is \$5.00 each. Cash is the only acceptable form of payment that can be made at the Club. Large purchases must have a Cabana Rental associated with it.
2. Member families can earn guest wristbands during the season including but not limited to attending the General Membership meeting and work details for pool opening and closing. Guest wristbands can also be earned by referring a new member family to Chabot Swim Club. Early dues payment (check your invoice for exact date) can also earn guest wristbands (check your invoice for number of wristbands).
3. Guest wristbands which have "Chabot Swim Club Guest" printed on them do not expire at the end of the season. Punch cards, blank wristbands, dated wristbands, and any color guest wristbands distributed prior to June 2018 were phased out and exchanged for new Marlin's teal-blue colored guest wristbands. Only new Marlin's teal-colored wristbands marked with the member's key # will be accepted after July 1, 2018. Please contact boardmembers@chabotswimclub.org if you have any questions.
4. Guest wristbands are **non-transferrable and are to be surrendered to the Club upon cancelation of membership.**
5. Members are responsible for the safekeeping of their guest wristbands at all times. The member's key number is written on each of their wristbands for easy identification.
6. All guests must wear a guest pass wristband at all times upon entering the facility regardless of whether or not they utilize the pool, tennis courts, or basketball court.
7. Gatekeepers and/or Lifeguards will not hold onto unused guest passes for members. The member is responsible for collecting any unused wristbands at the end of the day.
8. Abuse of the guest pass policy is a financial hardship to the rest of the membership; **guest pass wristbands may not be sold to non-members and any member caught selling wristbands to non-members will place their entire family membership in jeopardy of revocation.**
9. A member's guest is permitted use of the Club only while that member is present at the club.
10. Members are responsible for their observance of all rules by their guests. It is the member's responsibility to review rules with guests prior to or immediately upon entering the club.
11. There is a maximum of **SIX (6) guests per membership family allowed each day.** Please email the board at boardmembers@chabotswimclub.org for permission to bring 7-10 guests without renting a cabana. Any more than 10 guests will automatically require a cabana or patio pad rental, there will be no exceptions.
12. Guest wristband usage:

A. Member must accompany each of his or her guests to the check-in area. Member will identify themselves by key number and provide personal identification.

B. At that time, the member will identify the guest who will present a guest pass wristband to the gatekeeper on duty.

C. The guest pass wristband will be marked with the current date and is then valid for that guest for the remainder of the date marked.

D. The guest must keep this guest pass wristband on at all times while at the Club (swim areas, restrooms, tennis courts, basketball court, and picnic areas).

E. For those members from 8th-12th Grade bringing a guest, the guests must be able to provide a Student/School ID to the lifeguards. If no ID is available, the guest will NOT be able to enter the facility.

CABANA AND PATIO PAD RENTALS

1. Cabanas and Patio Pads may be requested via the online portal at least 7 days in advance. Any request that comes in with less than 5 days notice, is likely to be denied.
2. The loudspeaker is for paging and announcing by Lifeguards. System is for an emergency ONLY and not for any other purpose. Never use it to amplify music.
3. In order to assure the comfort of all members and guests, there will be a limit to 2 parties per Cabana, per day.
4. There are no cabana rentals on holidays when maximum capacity is expected, and the maximum number of guests allowed per membership will remain at 6 guests. Additional guests past the 6 will be denied on Holidays.
5. Members will be responsible for clean-up of their party area. If the area is not cleaned, there will be a \$100 cleaning fee assessed and invoiced to the member that rented the area.
6. All cabana rentals are subject to availability and cannot be confirmed until payment has been received by the Club. Cabana rental invoices must be paid in full within 72-hours of receiving the emailed invoice. If we do not receive payment in full via our online system within this timeframe, we will be forced to offer the cabana to the next member on the waitlist. Cash and checks are not acceptable forms of payment.
7. Cabana Rental Total Count Maximum: 50, Patio Pad Rental Total Count Maximum: member + 10 Guests.
8. Renter (also referred to as member host) accepts full responsibility for their guests. Lifeguards will provide one (1) warning if they see any underage drinking and have been instructed to call police for a second violation. If the police are called, the member host's entire family membership is subject to revocation.
9. If an event must be canceled, written notice must be given to Boardmembers@chabotswimclub.org at least 7 days prior to the date of the event in order to qualify for a refund.
10. Refunds will not be issued if the event is canceled or requested with less than 7 days' written notice.
11. Each membership is limited to three cabana rentals per season (April - October).
12. All guest wristbands for cabana rentals will be kept in the guard shack and distributed by a Lifeguard.
13. All non-member guests must wear a guest wristband, paid for by the host and provided by a Lifeguard, to enter the facilities.
14. Unused wristbands will be returned to the member host at the end of the event.

15. Event guests' behavior is the sole responsibility of the member host.
16. Member host must be present during the event at all times of the event.
17. All Chabot Swim Club rules apply and are to be followed by member host's guests.
18. Minors must be accompanied by an adult

CLUB OPERATIONS

1. Keep the club gate locked at all times. Never leave the gates ajar or blocked open.
2. Both pools may be used only when a lifeguard is on duty for anyone under the age of 16. This is for safety and mandated by Club Insurance Carrier.
3. Members are responsible for ANY damage caused by themselves, their children, or their guests.
4. Adult Members are responsible for the conduct of their children.
5. AN ADULT MUST ACCOMPANY CHILDREN IN THE CLUB AT ALL TIMES DURING THE OFF SEASON.
6. During On Season, each member MUST check in with at the gate upon entering the club and PRESENT PICTURE ID for those over the age of 18. Indicate Key number, member name, number of family members entering and number of guests if applicable. A guest pass wristband must be on record with the gate attendant for each guest, once a day. Special arrangements may be made with the Board of Directors for house guests.
7. Place refuse in the containers provided (Green = Organics; Blue = Recycling; Black/Brown = Trash).
8. Leave the patio, barbecue area, tables, etc. clean when you leave. Adults using the patio area should be careful to see that any breakable picnic accessories are removed when the area is vacated.
9. Return all sports equipment and supplies to the office when you have finished using them.
10. Do your best to be considerate of others and respectful to the Lifeguards.

SWIM TEST

It has been determined by the Board that for safety reasons Lifeguards will be implementing a swim test with the following rules

All children ages 10 years old and under may be required to take a swim test at the discretion of the Lifeguard

Deep End (Diving Board Area) Child must be able to swim unassisted the 2 widths (back and forth) of the Deep End. And keep head above water for one minute.

The Blue Half-way line: Child must be able to swim from the blue line to the end of the pool and and keep head above water for one minute
